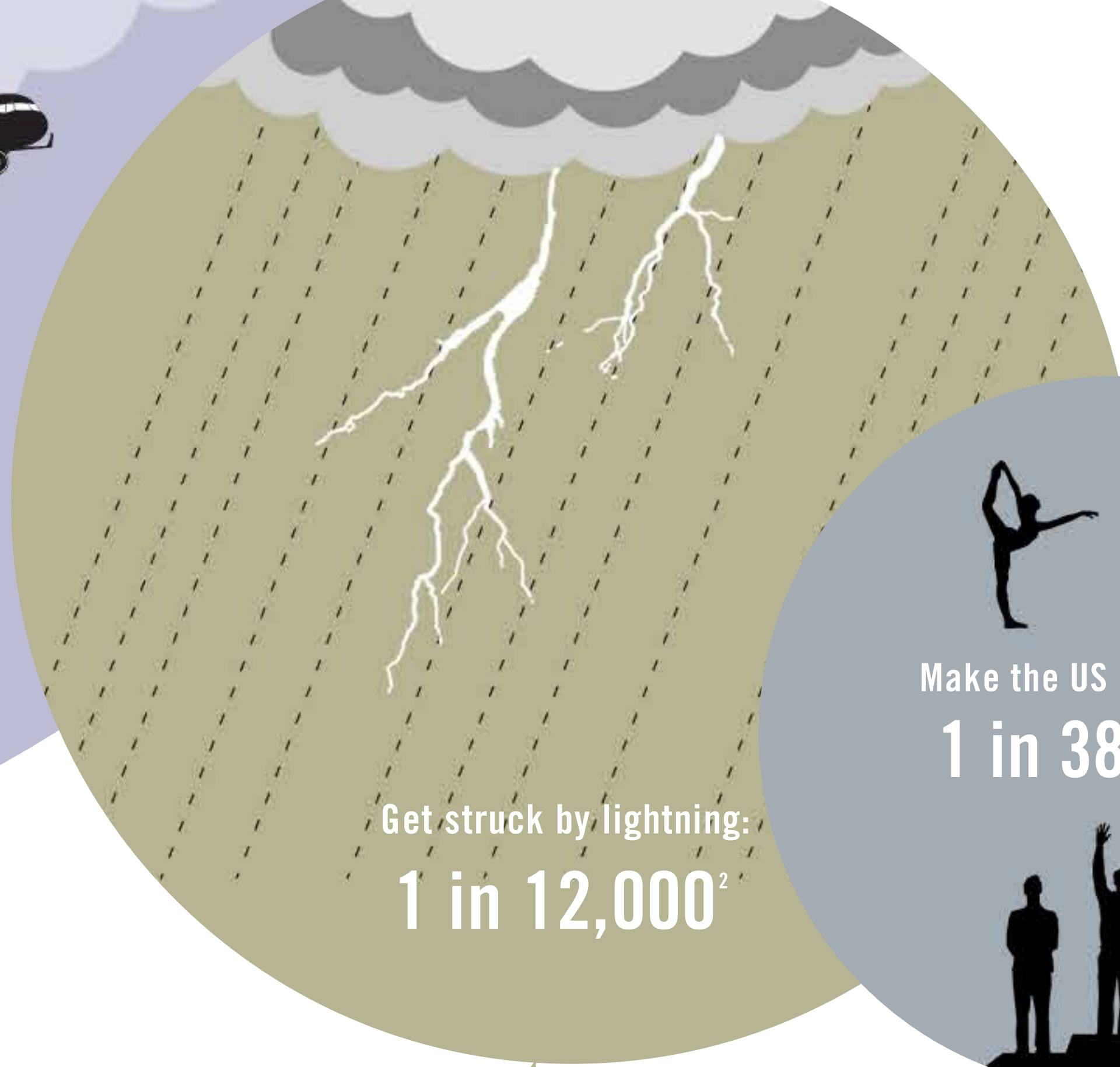


# THE ODDS A CHILD WILL...
